Scouting Event with the Le Sueur Rotary Club Fast for Hope.

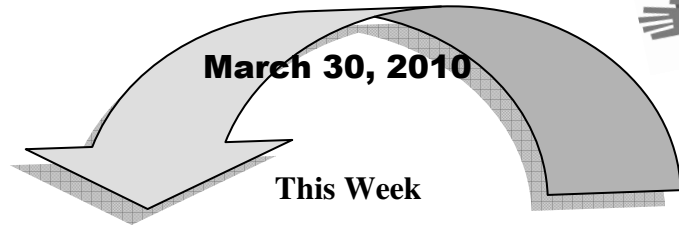
